

# STEPHANIE'S TIPPING GUIDE

HOTELS	
Housekeeping	\$2-5 <u>per night</u> (depending on how much cleaning is needed to be done OR was done the night before) Best to be paid every day instead of at the end of your stay.
Valet Parking	\$5 for standard hotels, \$10 for 5-star/luxury hotels
Porter/Bell Man	\$1-2 per bag (depending on weight)
Concierge	\$5 or more PER request...and even more if the request is complicated
ALL-INCLUSIVE RESORTS (Sun destinations)	
Housekeeping	\$1-2 <u>per night</u> (or more depending on how high-end the resort is) Best to be paid every day instead of at the end of your stay.
Porter/Bell Man	\$1-2 per bag (depending on weight)
Bartenders	\$1 per drink order (even if it's 2-3 drinks), \$5 or more if top-notch service and/or large drink order
Restaurant Service	\$1-5 per meal - depending on how high-end the resort is or if service level warrants it.
Concierge	\$5 or more PER request...and even more if the request is complicated
Airport Transfers	10% of total charge
Spa Services	10% of total charge
Tour (Excursion) Guides	\$5-10 depending on how good the tour was
TRANSPORTATION	
Taxis	10% of total charge
Ubers/Shared Rides	Not necessary most most allow you to tip whatever you like. Check with each service for more details.
Airport Transfers	10% of total charge
Flight Attendants	Most are uncomfortable accepting tips, but if it is warranted and discreet, tip or gift as you like.
FOOD SERVICE	
Restaurant Service	In Canada and U.S., 15% is standard in most areas, but 20% is more acceptable in larger centres.
Deliveries	5-10% of total charge, depending on speed of service, condition of food, etc.
Bartenders	\$1 per drink, except for cocktails - tip more depending on complexity of the recipe. Don't forget that 2-for-1 specials should still warrant twice the tips!
